He had ordered his family members to slaughter Tate,

who was eight-and-a-half months pregnant, and three of her friends at her home above Beverly Hills. Stephen Parent was a fifth unfortunate victim that night. He had driven to the property to see if caretaker William Garreston wanted to buy his AM/FM Clock radio, and had stayed on for a beer at the guest house. He was shot multiple times when he wound down the window at the electric gate as he left. Charles Manson, one of America's most hated murderers and the mastermind cult leader behind the barbaric slaughter of nine innocent people, is dead. He and his followers committed the series of ritualistic murders that included pregnant actress Sharon Tate at four locations in 1969. He was 83 when he breathed his last only days ago. When the Beatles first came to the United States, in February 1964, Charles Manson was an inmate in the United States Penitentiary at McNeil Island, in southern Puget Sound. He was serving a sentence for attempting to cash a forged U.S. Treasury check; [1]. Manson taught his followers that they were the reincarnation of the original Christians, and that the Romans were the establishment. He strongly implied that he was Christ; he often told a story envisioning himself on the cross with the nails in his feet and hands. Sometime around 1967, he began using the alias "Charles Willis Manson." He often said it very slowly ("Charles's Will Is Man's Son")—implying that his will was the same as that of the Son of Man.
