An individual's basal metabolic rate– the rate at which the body uses energy while at rest– can affect how long tramadol remains in the system. A person with a higher basal metabolic rate is burning more energy while their body is at rest which helps in metabolizing and ridding the body of a drug. Another reason those with higher basal metabolic rates may be able to rid the body of tramadol faster is that a high basal metabolic rate usually indicates a lower amount of body fat, leaving less space for tramadol to bind to fat and remain in the body. Cut-off: 100 ng/ml This test will be positive if the sample tested contains at least 100 nanograms of tramadol per milliliter of urine, or negative if the sample contains less or not at all. Tramadol is broken down in the liver and excreted mostly by the TEENneys in the urine. However, about 7 percent of people are "poor metabolizers" of tramadol, and it takes them longer to break it down. As a result, they have more active drug in their bloodstream for a longer time. These people are especially at risk if taking other medications that further reduce the actions of the enzymes that break down tramadol. It may take 10 to 15 days since the last fentanyl dose to obtain the first negative urine drug screen. Blood alcohol concentration (BAC) is the percentage of alcohol in their body. Mathematically, it is the total number of grams of ethanol (alcohol) in 100 milliliters of their blood. There are several key factors affecting a person's BAC. These tests typically examine a sample of urine for the presence of alcohol, marijuana, amphetamines, benzodiazepines, barbiturates, phencyclidine

(PCP), cocaine, lysergic acid diethylamide (LSD) or strong painkillers called opioids. But urine drug tests are not perfect and many prescribed and over-the-counter drugs can yield a false-positive test. This is especially likely if the drugs or their breakdown products have a chemical structure that is similar to the tested drugs. Drugs that may cause false-positive urine drug tests include certain antibiotics, cold medicines, psychiatric medications and painkillers. Once a person knows their BAC, it is a matter of dividing it by the rate of metabolizing alcohol (~0.12%/per hour).
